

Military Manpower – Tranche 1, DWCF - Army (O-6)



Position: Joint Task Force – Audit (JTF-A) – Audit Working Capital Fund (WCF) Lead Integrator (Army, O-6). This position reports to the JTF-A Assistant Chief of Staff and subject to senior level (general officer) rating. We are seeking a Department of the Army (preferred) Military Financial Manager with significant technical and leadership experience in the Defense Working Capital Fund (DWCF) to plan, organize and lead efforts to obtain an “unmodified” (clean) audit opinion on the DWCF financial statements for FY2027. The member will be responsible for planning and leading the newly established JTF-A Working Capital Fund audit remediation activities for multiple Audit Teams “A-Teams” in addressing complex financial operations of Department’s Revolving Fund financial reporting entities that finance critical activities like supply management and depot maintenance. This role involves high-level financial analysis, strategy development, and advising senior leadership.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Serve as JTF-A Department-wide WCF Lead Integrator: Responsible for leading approximately 6-8 JTF-A audit priority teams consisting of 5-10 members per team focused upon remediating audit issues materially impacted the Department’s ability to achieve a clean opinion from the Department’s Working Capital Fund programs. Lead will set and maintain “tone from the top” priorities for each of the Audit Teams “A-Teams.” Lead will facilitate planning, organizing, executing mission priorities and associated activities designed to remediate material issues impacting financial management and reporting towards auditability. Lead is responsible for keeping JTF-A leadership informed of progress, issues, and development of potential courses of action to remediate significant issues impacting the audit of WCF’s across the Department. Lead will oversee A-Teams and their progress as assigned to the DWCF workstream.

Experience and Qualifications:

Experience across all aspects of financial management for the DWCF, including financial and cost accounting, budgeting, reporting, and audit compliance. Army Base and Command, Defense Logistics Agency

Financial analysis and strategy: Performing in-depth studies and analyses and preparing recommendations to guide management and commanding officers on financial strategies.

Budget Execution: Managing the budget process, which involves analyzing program requirements, recommending fund allocations, and presenting and defending budget proposals to Navy leadership and external officials.

Policy interpretation: Interpreting and applying Department of the Army and Department of War (DoW) financial policy and guidance as it applies to WCF activities.

Ensuring financial integrity: Ensuring the timeliness, accuracy, and validity of all accounting, budgetary, and financial reports.

Experience: At least one year of specialized experience at the O-5/O-6 grade level or from civilian Federal service or equivalent experience in the private sector.

Security Clearance: DoW “Secret” clearance required

Travel Requirement: Estimated at 25%, **Location:** Washington, DC Metro Area; site location is Pentagon
