This reprogramming action transfers funds appropriated in Title III of division B of Public Law 116-136, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) to other applicable appropriations of the Department of Defense (DoD) pursuant to section 13001 of such Title. The reprogramming provides funding for expenses to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the coronavirus. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress.

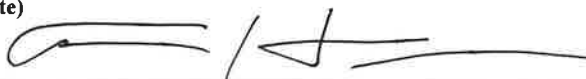
Explanation: Funds are required to purchase additional non-medical Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as exam gloves, isolation gowns, surgical masks, and goggles to ensure Department of Defense (DoD) has sufficient stock available for personnel to follow COVID-19 health protocols and continue its mission throughout the coronavirus pandemic. This funding will be used to increase inventory levels to meet anticipated demands related to the coronavirus pandemic. Given the current shortfall of available PPE globally, it is critical to get this requirement on order and have this increased inventory immediately available to support anticipated DoD demand on PPE for a second surge of the coronavirus. Without additional funding, DoD may not have sufficient quantities of PPE available to ensure the safety of its personnel to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the coronavirus and execute its mission during the crisis. This is a CARES Act division B, Title III, requirement.
