**PART I** of this reprogramming action transfers \$10.979 million of previously transferred Counter-Drug Activities funding from various components' Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 appropriations for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, back to the Drug Interdiction and Counter-drug Activities, Defense 25/25, appropriation, consistent with the provisions in division A of Public Law 118-47, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2024 as continued for fiscal year 2025 pursuant to division A of Public Law 119-4, Full Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2025.

**PART II** of this reprogramming action transfers \$227.179 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 25/25, appropriation to various components' Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 appropriations for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities consistent with the provisions in division A of Public Law 118-47, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2024 as continued for fiscal year 2025 pursuant to division A of Public Law 119-4, Full Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2025.

Realignment of funds between Drug Interdiction projects may only be accomplished with the concurrence of the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, Counternarcotics and Stabilization Policy. Realignment of funds between Drug Demand Reduction Program projects may only be accomplished with the concurrence of Office of the Executive Director for Force Resiliency, Under Secretary of Defense (Personnel and Readiness). No funds made available in this reprogramming action may be obligated for projects or activities pursuant to section 321, 322, or 333 of Title 10, United States Code. This reprogramming action impacts the Military Intelligence Program.
