This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

PART I of this reprogramming action transfers \$9.000 million between Air Force appropriations for proper execution. This reprogramming action uses \$9.000 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division A of Public Law 119-75, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2026.

PART II of this reprogramming action transfers \$95.428 million between Defense appropriations. Of these amounts, \$85.428 million is for the transfer of a congressional special interest item for proper execution from Missile Procurement, Air Force, 26/28 to Procurement of Ammunition, Air Force, 26/28, and \$10.0 million is for the transfer of a congressional special interest item for proper execution from Defense Health Program, 26/26 to Defense Health Program, 26/27.
