This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, affect special interest items, or initiate a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$40.031 million within the following Defense appropriations: \$14.622 million within the Other Procurement, Army, 25/27, appropriation; \$21.626 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 25/26, appropriation; and \$3.783 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 25/26, appropriation.

Explanation: Funds are required to accelerate development of Accessions Information Environment (AIE) software by on-boarding 9 additional software development teams to complete the Enlisted Recruiting functions four months ahead of schedule. AIE acceleration will enable approximately 22,000 recruiters across the Active, National Guard, and Reserve components to adopt modern technology, improve recruiter productivity, and gain operational efficiency across all recruiting missions. This acceleration also shortens the overall program development timeline by one year (2029 to 2028) and allows the Army to retire a 30-year-old legacy system.
