To effectuate a rescission of the remaining \$44.057 million balance, sourcing from other programs is required. This is a congressional special interest item.~~

Explanation: Funds are required to fully comply with the \$82.000 million rescission to Long Range Kill Chains in the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2026. When the rescission was introduced in the Senate appropriation bill in July 2025, there was a mapping error in the monthly defense financial reporting, which resulted in an inaccurate unexecuted balance on the report. The program's true unexecuted balance at the time of the rescission was only \$37.943 million which was driven by launch schedule timing. This mapping error has since been identified and corrected. To effectuate a rescission of the remaining \$44.057 million balance, sourcing from other programs is required. This is a congressional special interest item.
