This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, affect special interest items, or initiate a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by Congress.

PART I of this reprogramming action realigns \$12.649 million between and within Defense appropriations. The transfers in this reprogramming action use \$8.600 million of general transfer authority pursuant to Section 8005 of division A of Public Law 119-75, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2026.

PART II of this reprogramming action transfers \$290.344 million between and within Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$238.344 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 1412 of division A of P.L. 119-4, the Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2025.
